

Public Notice of Rights under Title VI: YOUR RIGHTS UNDER TITLE VI OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT



Hiawathaland Transit

Hiawathaland Transit is committed to ensuring that no person is excluded from participation in, denied the benefits of, or otherwise subjected to discrimination on the basis of race, color, or national origin under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance without regard to whether specific projects or services are federal funded. Transit programs and services are distributed in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act and related nondiscrimination authorities. Additionally, Hiawathaland Transit is committed to ensuring that its programs incorporate access for people with limited English proficiency.

Any person who believes that they, individually, or as a member of any specific class of persons, have been subjected to discrimination on the basis of race, color, or national origin may file a discrimination complaint with Hiawathaland Transit using the complaint form located on Hiawathaland Transit's website.
