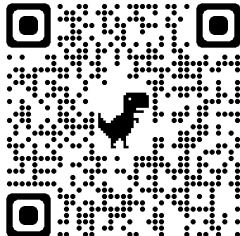


Passenger Conduct & Responsibility

- Passengers are required to pay the necessary fare before their ride(s). Passengers will be charged the \$3.50 route fare for any no-call, no-shows
- Hiawathaland Transit provides curb to curb service only; drivers do not help individuals into homes; apartment buildings or businesses
- Passengers may board with items/bags that can be carried on and off the bus in a single trip and must remain under their full control
- Inappropriate language, bothering other passengers, horseplay, fighting, carrying of weapons, or possession of illegal drugs will not be tolerated
- No food, beverages, or smoking on buses

Additional Information

- Each bus is handicap accessible
- 24 hour advance notice is encouraged for any ride needing the use of a lift
- Assistants accompanying a person with a disability ride free
- Tokens or passes are encouraged
- Drivers DO NOT make change
- Children 2 and under ride free with a paying adult. Maximum 1 free child per adult
- Up to a 4 block route deviation may be available, but should be requested and scheduled through our dispatch specialists
- Buses DO NOT enter trailer/mobile home parks, apartment complexes, or multi-use/multi-family dwellings
- Please understand traffic and weather conditions may delay buses

Service Description

This route is an additional service available within the communities of Faribault and Northfield and operates Monday - Friday. The connect route begins at Northfield City Hall (2801 Washington St.) and will connect at Faribault City Hall (2nd Ave. NW). Once you are connected at the transfer locations you will need to utilize the local public transit routes, or the Dial-A-Ride, to complete your trip to your final destination. Lifts will need to be pre-registered due to limited space. Call dispatch at 866-623-7505, option 1, if you have any questions or to schedule your ride.

Fares/Tokens

Single Ride Cost.....\$3.50

Riders are responsible for any fare necessary to get to City Hall and to their final destination within each community.

Exact change is required as drivers are unable to make change. Please have your token ready when boarding the transit bus.

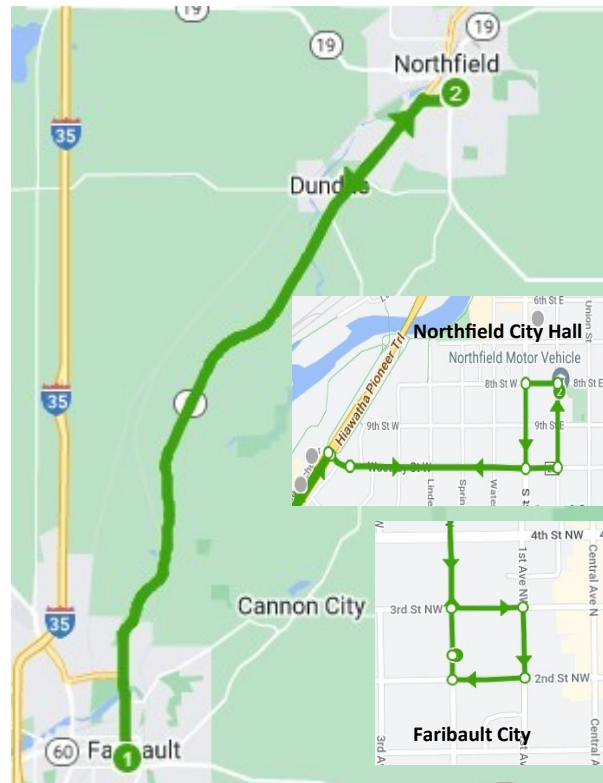
