

# Our Services

Hiawathaland Transit is a public transit, curb-to-curb bus service operated by Three Rivers Community Action, Inc. and is available to anyone for any reason. Riders of all ages use our bus service to go to places such as work, school, the grocery store, doctors office or pharmacy, or to make friendly visits and many more locations! Our buses will transport up to three miles from city limits within your service community.

Our dispatchers are trained to handle all of your transportation needs and place you with the service that best meets your individual needs.

# For your Information

All of our vehicles are handicap accessible. When scheduling your ride, please inform the dispatcher if you would like to use the “lift” to board the vehicle.

We ask that you be ready and waiting 10 minutes in advance of your scheduled time and know the bus can run up to 10 minutes past your scheduled time.

# Service Description

This route is an additional service available within the communities of Faribault and Northfield and operates Monday - Friday. The connect route begins at Faribault City Hall (2nd Ave NW) and will connect at Northfield City Hall (2801 Washington St). Once you are connected at the transfer locations you will need to utilize the local public transit routes, or the Dial-A-Ride, to complete your trip to your final destination. Lifts will need to be pre-registered due to limited space. Call dispatch at 866-623-7505, option 1, if you have any questions or to schedule your ride.

# Fares/Tokens

Single Ride Cost.....\$3.50

Riders are responsible for any fare necessary to get to City Hall and to their final destination within each community.

Exact change is required as drivers are unable to make change. Please have your fare/token ready when boarding the transit bus.
