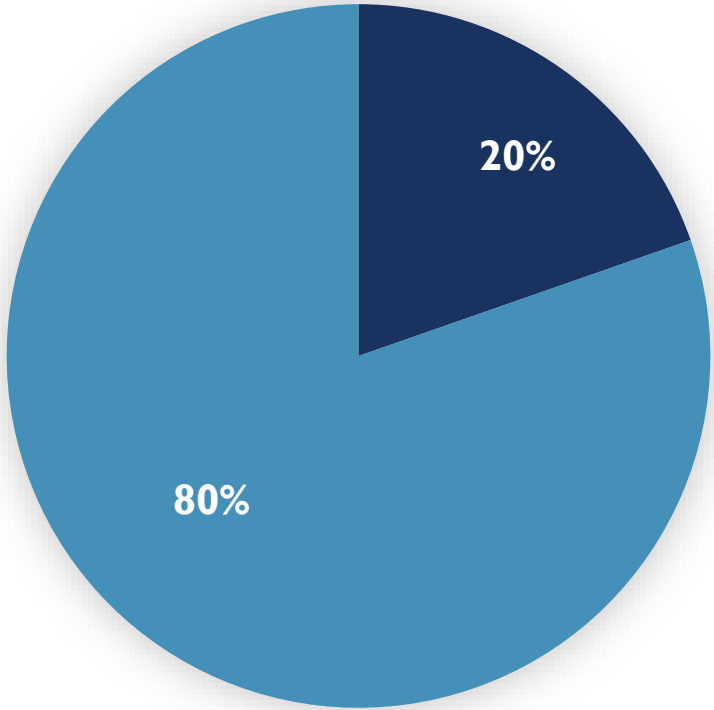

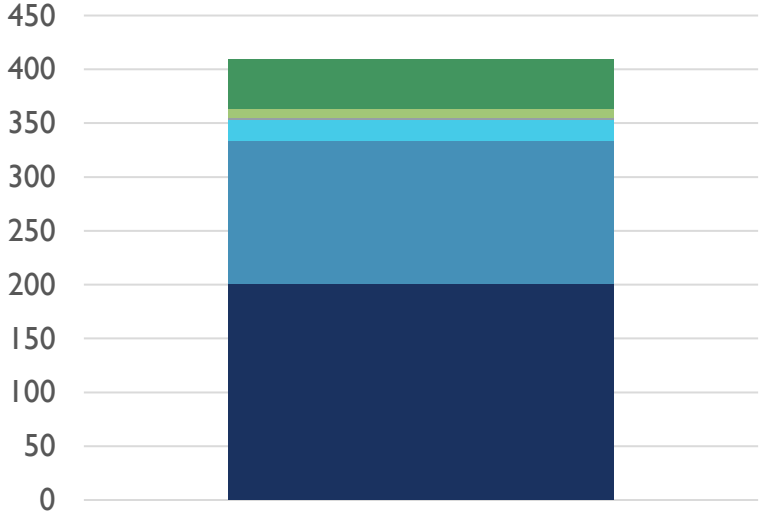
THE NUMBERS – 2021 CALENDAR YEAR

Unduplicated Persons Served = 346



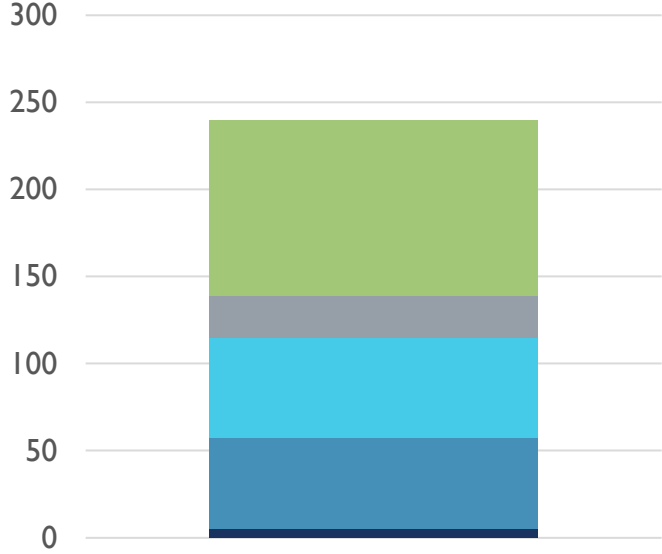

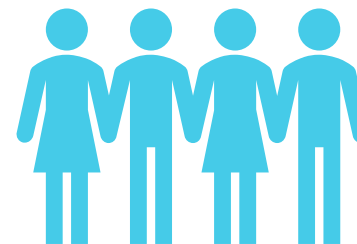
