PROGRAM NAME	SERVICES PROVIDED
Housing Development	Development of and rehabilitation of safe, affordable rental and owner-occupied housing in Southeast Minnesota.
Continuum of Care	Twenty-county planning body preventing, responding to and ending homelessness; securing federal, state, local funds for homeless assistance.
Down Payment Assistance	Down payment and closing cost assistance program for eligible buyers in southeastern Minnesota.
Home Ownership Assistance	Home ownership training, counseling, and financial coaching for first-time home buyers.
Energy Assistance	Assistance to households experiencing low-income for home heating costs and crisis assistance for emergency furnace repairs.
Housing Advocacy Services	Comprehensive services for households experiencing low-income to attain economic self-sufficiency: housing assistance, case management, and budgeting; SNAP application assistance; and referrals to partners for other services.
Head Start	Pre-school education facilitating growth and development of children and self-sufficiency of families.
Early Head Start	Home Visiting program serving infants and toddlers Birth-3 years old which focuses on the relationship between children and their parents.
Advocacy for Older Adults and Caregivers	Education, problem solving, and resource referral for older adults and their caregivers to assist them to live independently longer.
Weatherization	Assistance to households experiencing low-income for reducing energy consumption and heat loss.
Meals on Wheels	Meals delivered to people over 60 or disabled who are home bound and have difficulty preparing their own nutritious meals.
Northfield Child Care Center	Center Based Child Care and Early Head Start Partnership for Infants and Toddlers at our Northfield location. Families with infants and toddlers under the age of 3 are eligible for Early Head Start.
Hiawathaland Transit	Public transit service that provides dial-a-ride in Goodhue, Rice, and Wabasha counties and route services in Faribault, Northfield, and Red Wing. HART program supports volunteer drivers transporting older adults and persons with disabilities.
